

ESSENTIAL GUIDE PITCH-SIDE FIRST AID



It's essential to have appropriate first aid equipment readily accessible whenever any rugby activity is taking place. Every club should complete a risk assessment to determine what pitch-side first aid is required.

Emergency first aid should only be administered by appropriately trained personnel.

Each first aider should be appropriately equipped, ideally with their own first aid bag. At least one first aid box should also be situated in your clubhouse.
